Files of this type and auxiliary type contain a packed Apple IIGS Super Hi-Res screen image.

---

Files of type \$C0 and auxiliary type \$0001 contain a packed Apple IIGS Super Hi-Res screen image, which is created by passing the entire 32K Super Hi-Res screen area, including the scan line control bytes (SCB) and color tables, through the `PackBytes` routine.

If you restore a file of this type to its original 32K size with `UnPackBytes`, you can save the unpacked data to a file of type \$C1 and auxiliary type \$0000 (Apple IIGS Super Hi-Res Graphics Screen Image).
