- ⌘-Delete: Delete character at cursor
- ⇧-Delete: Delete character at cursor
- ⇧-Return: Force a page break
- ⇧-Period: Insert 4 spaces/drop cursor [T]
- ⇧-Comma: Delete 4 chars./drop cursor [T]
- ⇧-Space: Insert a space
- ⇧-Tab: Cursor to right margin
  - ⇧-←: Cursor to beginning of line
  - ⇧-→: Cursor to end of line
  - ⇧-↓: Find forced page break
- ⇧-A: Add files to Desktop
- ⇧-C: Center
- ⇧-D: Delete word at cursor
- ⇧-F: Find new word
- ⇧-G: Go to Marker #1
- ⇧-I: Indent 3 characters
- ⇧-J: Justify both margins
- ⇧-K: Calculate and find page
- ⇧-L: Left justify
- ⇧-M: Set Marker #1
- ⇧-N: Name
- ⇧-O: Indent zero
- ⇧-P: Print, no questions
- ⇧-Q: Quick Desktop switch
- ⇧-S: Save and remove
- ⇧-U: Undo last ⇧-D, ⇧-Y or ⇧-Z
- ⇧-Y: Delete entire line
- ⇧-Z: Zap to end of file

[T] = Temporary Macro. To redefine:

1. Press ⌘-X, then Comma or Period.
2. Type the actual macro keystrokes.
3. Press Control-@.
