

Instructions for Forth Disk Volumes

F01 & F02

FIG-FORTH78 is provided courtesy of the Forth Interest Group, PO Box 1105, San Carlos, CA 94070. It was implemented by William D. Wurzel of Washington Apple Pi and produced by Apple-Dayton. Forth is not case sensitive and works with 80-column cards like Videx and //e. Change line 190 of the startup program to turn on your card before running Forth. Forth treats the disk as a sequence of 1024-byte 'screens'. Thus, on the disk volume F01, screen 0-11 are DOS and screens 12-23 are Integer Basic. Screens 24-59 are free for your Forth source code.

To see the contents of screen 24, enter '24 LIST'. To compile the definitions contained therein, enter '24 LOAD'.

Disk volume F02 contains the Forth Tutorial. It starts on screen 1 and fills the disk. Therefore F02 does not contain DOS and will NOT BOOT!! To use the tutorial, first boot F01. Then press 'R' to run Forth. Now insert F02 and enter '1 LOAD'. Other instructions for using the tutorial will then be presented.
